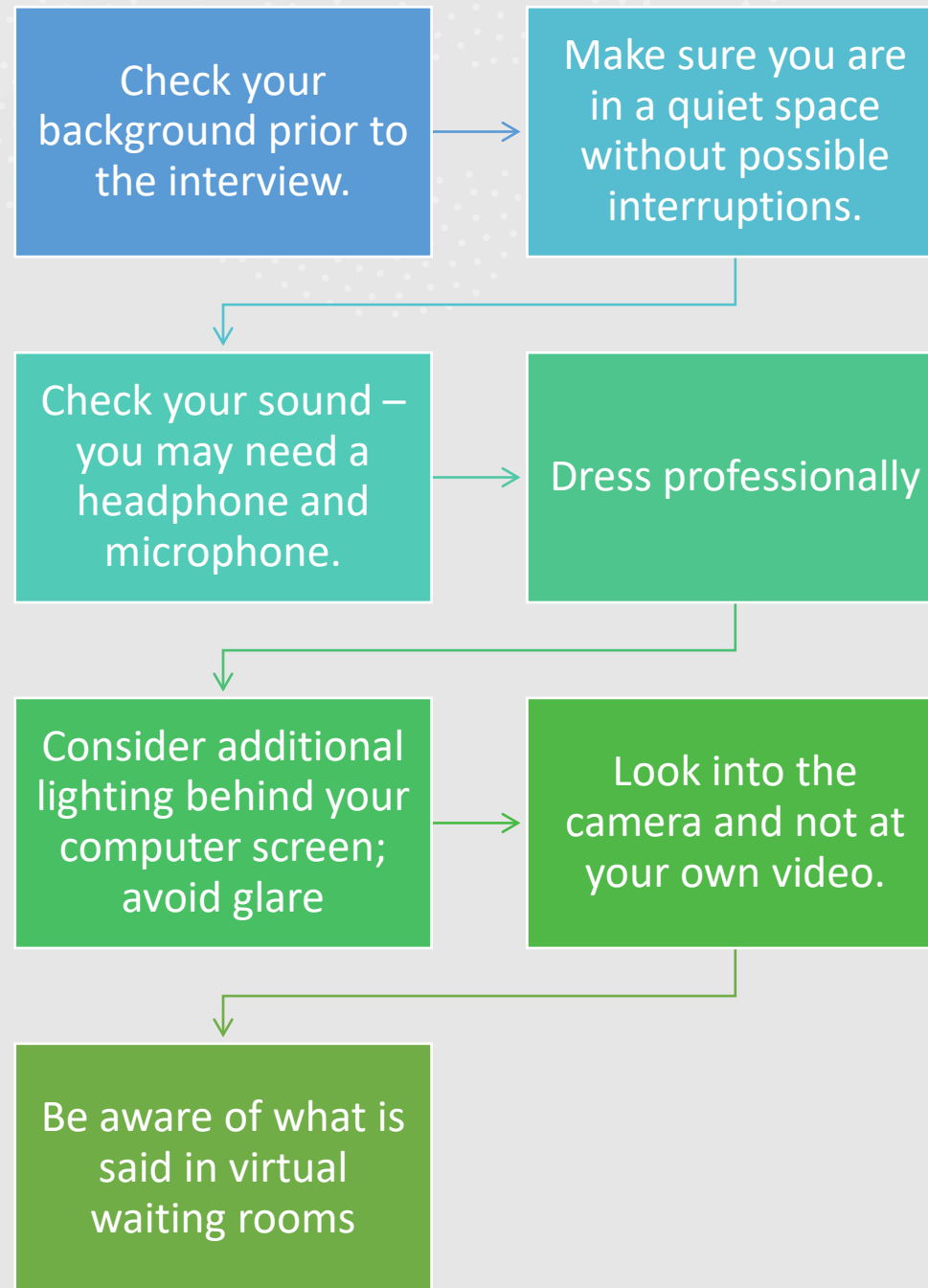


Checklist for your Virtual GI Fellowship Interview



Preparing for Interviews- Virtual and In-person

Tell

Have a story to tell

- How did you get to where you are today?
- How do you apply your experiences to your current practice?
- What has contributed to your personal growth?

Walk

Walk the interviewer through your CV

- Some interviewers may have seen each detail of your application
- Highlight your accomplishments during
- Reiterate key points from your personal statement

Prepare

Prepare your answers to common questions.

- What interests you about the program?
- What are your strengths and weaknesses?
- Do you have a patient encounter that stayed with you?

Ask

Ask questions about the program

- Its ok to repeat with different interviewers!
- Leave your interviewer confident of your interest in the program specifically
